**CERTIFYING THE REVISED IMPERIAL COUNTY FARM BUREAU
SEDIMENT TOTAL MAXIMUM DAILY LOAD COMPLIANCE PROGRAM
AS ADEQUATE TO CORRECT IMPAIRMENTS OF
CHLORPYRIFOS AND DIAZINON IN THE ALAMO AND NEW RIVERS
IMPERIAL COUNTY, CALIFORNIA**

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region (Regional Water Board) will hold a public hearing to consider a proposed Resolution certifying the revised Imperial County Farm Bureau (ICFB) Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) Compliance Program as being adequate to address water quality impairment of the Alamo and New Rivers due to the pesticides chlorpyrifos and diazinon. The Regional Water Board will hold the public hearing on the proposed Resolution during its September 2013 Board meeting, which is scheduled as follows:

If the presentation may take longer, please let Regional Water Board staff know before speaking so that the presentation can be appropriately scheduled at the hearing. Where speakers can be grouped by affiliation or interest, such groups will be expected to select a spokesperson and not be repetitive. To ensure accuracy of the record, the Regional Water Board requests that any speakers who have prepared written statements for oral presentation at the hearing submit those statements to Regional Water Board staff before or during the hearing.
