**NOTICE OF  
CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT SCOPING MEETING**

In the Matter of a Proposed Waiver of Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Wastes  
from Agricultural Operations in the Imperial Valley

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region (Regional Water Board) staff will hold a California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Scoping Meeting, pursuant to California Public Resources Code Section 21083.9, to seek public input on the appropriate scope and content of the environmental documents to be prepared pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Pub. Resources Code, § 21000 et seq.) regarding a proposed Waiver of Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) for Discharges of Wastes from Agricultural Operations in the Imperial Valley. The proposed Waiver will also address a few hundred acres under cultivation in the Town of Felicity, CA. The purpose of the environmental review will be to determine whether the proposed Waiver (the "project" under CEQA) could have a significant effect on the environment.

California Water Code Section 13269 provides the state and regional water boards (Water Boards) with the authority to waive WDRs for a specific discharge or type of discharge if the board determines after any necessary board meeting that the Waiver is consistent with any applicable state or regional water quality control plan and is in the public interest. The proposed Waiver would address the actual and potential impacts that agricultural wastewater discharges originating within the Imperial Valley have on water quality. Specifically, the Waiver would address: 1) storm water runoff from irrigated lands, and 2) irrigation return water, which includes surface discharges (also known as "tailwater") to the extent there are any in areas not tiled, and subsurface discharges (known as "tile water" or "seepage") in tiled areas. It will also address the potential water quality impacts from drain operation and maintenance activities.
