The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region (Colorado River Basin Water Board) is releasing for public review and comment proposed Order R7-2020-0017 (Proposed Order) to AM Wind Repower LLC (Permittee) for the Alta Mesa Wind Repower Project (Project). The Project site is located on private lands in unincorporated Riverside County, approximately 11 miles northwest of the City of Palm Springs. This Project would install seven new wind turbine generators (WTG) to replace 159 old WTGs at the existing wind project located on land zoned Wind Energy (W-E) to produce up to 27 megawatts (MW) of wind energy. The Project is expected to impact waters of the state.

The Colorado River Basin Water Board intends to consider adopting the Proposed Order during a public hearing that will commence at the time and place indicated:

Location: Virtual Meeting via Zoom Video and Teleconference

As a result of the COVID-19 emergency and the Governor's Executive Orders to protect public health by limiting public gatherings and requiring social distancing, the Board meeting will occur solely via remote presence.

Interested persons are invited to attend and express their views orally on this matter at the public hearing. The Colorado River Basin Water Board requests that those persons wishing to speak at the hearing provide a copy of their oral comments in writing before or during the hearing to ensure accuracy of the record.
