NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMIT AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS PROPOSED ORDER R7-2023-XXXX

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region (Colorado River Basin Water Board) is releasing for public review and comment Tentative Waste Discharge Requirements Order R7-2023-XXXX (Tentative Order), which will serve as the reissuance of National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit Number CA0104264 and Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) for the following discharger and facility:

COUNTRY LIFE MHRVP ASSET PARTNERS, L.P. (Discharger)

COUNTRY LIFE MOBILE HOME AND RECREATIONAL VEHICLE PARK (MHRVP) WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT 375 EAST ROSS ROAD EL CENTRO – IMPERIAL COUNTY (Facility)

Country Life MHRVP Asset Partners, L.P. (Discharger) has applied for reissuance of the Country Life Mobile Home and Recreational Vehicle Park (MHRVP) Wastewater Treatment Plant (Facility) NPDES Permit, previously issued per WDRs Order R7-2018-0010, which is issued pursuant to section 402 of the federal Clean Water Act (33 U.S.C. § 1342), and pursuant to the Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act (Wat. Code, § 13000 et seq.).

BACKGROUND

The Discharger owns and operates a wastewater collection, treatment, and disposal system (the Facility) and provides service to a population of approximately 600 individuals residing at the Mobile Home and RV Park located in the town of El Centro. The permitted maximum daily flow limitation is equal to the design capacity of the wastewater treatment plant which is 0.15 MGD. The Facility is located in the NE ¼ of Section 10, T16S, R14E, SBB&M. The discharge from the Facility consists of disinfected secondary treated wastewater.

The treatment plant is an extended aeration package plant. Wastewater is conveyed from the mobile home and RV park by gravity into a series of two lift stations that pump collected wastewater to the Facility for secondary treatment. Wastewater pumped to the Facility passes through a manual bar rack, into a primary aeration basin, followed by a re-aeration basin, then into a clarifier located in the center of the package plant. Return activated sludge from the clarifier is pumped into the re-aeration phase of the plant. Waste activated sludge from the clarifier is pumped to a sludge digester section of the package plant. Clarifier wastewater effluent is treated by gravel filtration. The gravel filter is backwashed once per day and the backwash is recycled to the headworks. Periodically, gravel is added to replace a small amount lost during the backwash and operation. Once or twice each year, staff completely exchange the gravel. Following the backwash, wastewater undergoes ultraviolet (UV) disinfection. The UV system is inspected and cleaned twice per year.

Sludge from the digester is discharged to two on-site sludge drying beds. The Discharger installed a berm around the sludge drying beds. Dried sludge is disposed of at the CR&R Inc. landfill located in El Centro, California.

Wastewater is discharged from Discharge Point 001 to the Alder Drain, a water of the United States. The Alder Drain carries the discharge from the Facility to the Central Drain, which flows for approximately 10 miles before entering the Alamo River at a point approximately 38 miles upstream of the Salton Sea.

SUBMISSION OF WRITTEN COMMENTS

The Colorado River Basin Water Board will accept comments during a 30-day public comment period, which ends on **September 22, 2023**. Written comments on the proposed Order must be received no later than **5:00 p.m.** on **September 22, 2023**. Comments received by this deadline will be included in the administrative record.
