The Project site is located along Riviera Drive, approximately 1.6 miles south of I-10 in the City of Blythe, Riverside County, California, 92225

Project Description:

The CRCA will perform maintenance in a backwater channel adjacent to the Colorado River to restore wet season water flows and allow boats to launch, navigate, and exit the channel safely. Overgrown vegetation near the banks that is restricting water flow and recreational access from private docks during the wet season will be cleared. Accumulated sediment from the center of the channel and outlet will be moved back to its original location near the shorelines. Approximately (but no more than) 0.2 acres of temporary impacts to Waters of the U.S. will occur in the southern portion of the

backwater channel and outlet as a result of these activities. No permanent impacts are identified.
