Project Name: Colorado River 500

Receiving Water: Colorado River

Location: The project is located in the City of Blythe, within Township 6 South, Range 23 East, SBB&M (33° 38' 18" N. Latitude, 114° 32' 29" W Longitude)

Project Description: The project will take place within a man made inlet on the western bank of the Colorado River that will provide the residents of the proposed Colorado River (CR) 500 subdivision and the general public on-site boating access to the Colorado River. The Applicant proposes to dredge material from the inlet floor and a portion of the bank at the entrance to the inlet, replace an existing pipe culvert, extend an existing boat ramp, install a boat dock and install a pedestrian bridge. The dredged material removed from the lagoon will be deposited at a dumpsite directly west of the lagoon and will be used as fill material for the proposed CR 500 subdivision project planned adjacent to the dredging site.
