**Applicant:** U.S. Bureau of Reclamation

**Project Name:** Walters Camp Bankline Stabilization

**Receiving Water:** Colorado River

**Location:** The project is located approximately 30 miles south of the City of Blythe, within Section 8, Township 11 South, Range 22 East, SBB&M (33° 14' 23.33" N Latitude by 114° 41' 11.04" W Longitude)

**Project Description:** At the request of the Walters Camp homeowners association, the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation proposes to stabilize a small reach of wash bankline located along the Colorado River. The proposed project will result in the placement of 100 cubic yards of riprap material (rock) along the eroded bankline to stop further erosion and protect adjacent properties. The bankline stabilization project will retain the integrity of the bank, reduce severe bank erosion and protect adjacent lands (property) along the bankline.
