Location:

The proposed project will take place in the City of Palm Springs, Riverside County, California, within Section 25, Township 4 South, Range 4 East, San Bernardino Baseline and Meridian.

The project location is further described as 33.7963° North Latitude by 116.5127° West Longitude.

Project Description:

The proposed project consists of the removal and reconstruction of concrete slope lining protecting the Palm Canyon Wash levee; the installation of a storm drain inlet structure; and installation of a new 24-inch diameter reinforced concrete pipe storm drain through the levee by trenching and backfilling the trench with imported material. Other work located outside Palm Canyon Wash includes reconstruction of a portion of existing curb and gutter in the Araby Circle cul-de-sac bulb and connecting the 24-inch diameter storm drain pipe from the end of the street through the Palm Canyon Wash levee. As proposed, the project will result in permanent impacts to 4-linear feet of unvegetated streambed.
