Location:

The proposed project will take place in the City of Palm Springs, Riverside County, California, within Section 19, Township 4 South, Range 5 East, San Bernardino Baseline and Meridian.

The project location is further described as 33.8025° North Latitude by 116.4954° West Longitude.

Project Description:

The Storm Drain Line 22 project consists of the installation of reinforced concrete storm drain along Vella Road and the City of Palm Springs Wastewater Treatment Plant to the Tahquitz Creek. The project consists of the installation of an 84-inch diameter storm drain pipe through the Tahquitz Creek levee by trenching and backfilling; installation of a concrete storm drain headwall with steel bar outlet protection; and installation of grouted rip-rap along the levee for erosion control. As proposed, the project will result in permanent impacts to 0.066 acre of vegetated streambed (approximately 0.011 acre for the placement of the concrete headwall and 0.055 acre of grouted rip-rap) and temporary impacts to 0.28 acre of vegetated streambed.
