State Route 95 Highway Widening

Receiving Water:

Unnamed ephemeral washes, which are tributary to Chemhuevi Wash, which connects to Lake Havasu / Colorado River

Location:

The Project is located along State Route 95, between post mile 42.4 and 43, approximately 15 miles south of the City of Needles, in San Bernardino County, California. The project is located in Sections 1 and 2 of Township 6 North, Range 22 East, San Bernardino Baseline and Meridian.

Project Description:

Caltrans proposes to add safety improvements to a portion of State Route 95 south of Needles, California. Caltrans would be adding an eight-foot wide shoulder on each side of the highway, rumble strips, a median buffer and improve drainage structures. An existing 18-inch diameter culvert will be replaced with two 18-inch diameter 80.5-foot long corrugated steel pipe culverts. Caltrans will also construct concrete headwalls at the inlet and outlet of the pipes and install rock slope protection at the outlet. The Project will result in permanent impacts to approximately 0.01 acre and temporary impacts to approximately 0.01 acre of nonwetland waters of the U.S.
