**Project Description:**

Bragg Crane & Rigging, Co. (Applicant), is requesting an after-the-fact Clean Water Act Section 404 Permit and 401 Certification for grading operations conducted on two existing bridge by-pass roads. The Applicant transported heavy equipment around two bridges between August 7 – 22, 2008 and graded the bridge by-pass roads to allow the transport of heavy equipment around the two bridges. The Applicant proposed to restore the by-pass roads to existing conditions. The grading activities resulted in temporary impacts to 0.0229 acre of dry wash.
