Location:

Mayflower County Park is located approximately six miles north of the City of Blythe, in Riverside County, California. The project site is located in Section 12, Township 6 South, Range 23 East, San Bernardino Baseline and Meridian at 33° 44' 21.58" N Latitude by 114° 32' 02.46" W Longitude.

Project Description:

The County of Riverside, Regional Park and Open-Space District, proposes to conduct maintenance dredging of the swimming beach portion of the Mayflower County Park Lagoon. The lagoon is an existing man made backwater area of the Colorado River in Mayflower County Park, an existing open-space, campground, and recreational area adjacent to the Colorado River. The District proposes to dredge approximately 771 cubic yards of material from approximately 1.7 acres of the southern section of the parks' existing public swimming area. The dredging operations shall restore the swimming beach portion of the lagoon to the original design contour, grade and depth. The District proposes to dispose of the dredged spoil material on land within the boundary of the park.
