Project Description:

The City of Palm Springs proposes to widen approximately 1900 linear feet of South Palm Canyon Drive starting at about Murray Canyon Drive and continuing south past Bogert Trail, ending before Acanto Drive. The road will be widened from its current average width of 64 feet to approximately 94 feet. The proposed project will result in the expansion of the bridge/box culvert over Cherly Creek. The roadway expansion project will result in temporary impacts to approximately 94 linear feet of Cherly Creek, an ephemeral wash channel, with an approximate impact area of 0.009 acre.
