Project Description:

The Bureau of Reclamation proposes to rehabilitate five backwater areas located along the lower Colorado River's Palo Verde Division. The backwaters are identified as: A-7, A-10, C-5, C-8, and C-10, see drawing No. 423-303-3132. However, only the C-5, C-8, and C-10 backwaters are located on the California side of the river. Rehabilitation would consist of restoring the existing inlet and outlet structures in order to improve water circulation through the backwaters. Currently the inlet and outlet structures are plugged (filled with sediment) and little to no water is flowing through them.
