Project Description:

The Desert Sands Unified School District (DSUSD) has constructed a new building at La Quinta High School, located at 79255 Blackhawk Way, La Quinta, California 92253. The new building is located near the southern boundary of the school site adjacent to the north bank of the Coachella Valley Stormwater Channel. Discussions with the Coachella Valley Water District (CVWD) indicated that there may be erosion of the banks of the Coachella Valley Stormwater Channel (CVSC) during periods of heavier rainfall and discharge that could impact La Quinta High School. Therefore, the CVWD requested DSUSD to install storm water channel slope protection along the north bank of the storm water channel from Adams Street on the west to Dune Palms Road on the east.

The proposed project includes installing slope protection (concrete lined banks) and rip rap to protect existing structures and prevent erosion from periodic storm water flows. The Coachella Valley Stormwater Channel is dry most of the year, with the exception of periodic storm events.
