Project Description:

United States Gypsum Company proposes a mine operation expansion within the permitted boundaries of its Plaster City Quarry (Quarry). The mine expansion is proposed to occur during the period of 2014-2020; the Quarry expansion will permanently impact 52.11 acres of desert alluvial streambeds. The proposed expansion will involve two phases of the mine development plan. The expansion will occur over approximately 135.5 acres of which 52.11 are classified as ephemeral streambeds with little to no vegetation.
