Project Description:

The proposed Project consists of:

- Replace the bridge along Mainline 2 (west track) at MP 657.37 on the Union Pacific Railroad Company (UPRR) Yuma Subdivision.
- MP 657.37 is located approximately 2.5 miles northeast of the community of Wister in Imperial County, California.
- The new bridge is needed to meet to comply with Federal Railroad Administration (FRA) regulations and UPRR safety and design standards.
- The bridge and rail line support Amtrak passenger service through Riverside County and the replacement will maintain and improve both freight and passenger rail service.
