Project Description:

The proposed Project consists of:

- The goal is to provide year-round access to the river at the marina. Needles Marina provides river access in the center of Needles to residents, tourists, the Sherriff's Water Patrol, and the research and enforcement units of the California Department of Fish and Wildlife.
- The marina is a closed area with only one inlet/outlet. When the river is rising, sediment-laden water is forced into the marina. Much of the sediment settles to the bottom of the marina. It is therefore necessary to periodically dredge the marina. The dredging is necessary to continue to provide marina services to the boating and regulatory groups that use the boat launch ramp.

Proposed Schedule (Start-up, duration, and completion dates):

The work is scheduled to begin as soon as the final permits have been approved (tentatively in 2017).
