Project Description:

The proposed Project consists of:

- UPRR plans to install a new bridge to replace the existing railroad bridge at MP 576.62 on the Yuma Subdivision, northwest of Palm Springs in Riverside County, California.
- Replace the existing bridge with a 100-foot bridge with concrete ties, composed of four 20-foot spans of prestressed concrete box (PCB) girder.
- The new bridge is needed to meet UPRR safety and design standards and to comply with Federal Railroad Administration regulations.
- The bridge and rail line support Amtrak passenger service through Riverside County and the replacement will maintain and improve both freight and passenger rail service.
