Project Description:

The proposed Project consists of:

- Remove and reconstruct rock slope protection will occur on Interstate 40 (I40) at post mile (PM) 134.0. The project will have work limited to Caltrans' bridge number 54-0872R (Bridge) that crosses over South Fork Piute Wash.
- There is a portion of the grouted rock slope protection that has failed due to erosion damage at the Bridge. In order to maintain the safety and integrity of the existing structure Caltrans proposes to remove the existing grouted rock slope protection (RSP) and reconstruct it to prevent further deterioration to the abutment caused by ephemeral flows.
- Replace new RSP protection at the base of the bridge. The RSP work will extend 70 feet north and south of the bridge. Caltrans will use 681 cubic yards of ¼ ton RSP and 910 square yards of RSP fabric (class 8).
