The proposed Project consists of:

- Repairing the under deck of the bridge which includes installation of hinge seat extender, cable hinge restrainer, and column casing.
- The project will bring the bridge up to Caltrans current roadway structure standards.
- The San Gorgonio Wash Bridge is a ten-span (westbound) and eight-span (eastbound) continuous reinforced concrete slab with two hinges.
