**Project Description:**

The proposed Project consists of:

- To replace the existing TST-BD Mainline 2 bridge at MP 671.07 with a 60-foot bridge with concrete ties, comprised of two 30-foot spans of PCB girders, similar to that of the existing Mainline 1 bridge.
- The new bridge is needed to meet UPRR safety and design standards and to comply with Federal Railroad Administration regulations.
- The bridge and rail line support Amtrak passenger service through Riverside County and the replacement will maintain and improve both freight and passenger rail service.
