**Project Description:**

The proposed Project consists of:

- Widening and updating the existing bridge between Southridge Drive and Araby Drive-Escoba Drive on Palm Canyon Drive. The bridge would be widened from ~58 feet to ~80 feet and allow for four 12 ft lanes, two 5 ft shoulders, associated barriers, and a 10 ft median.
- Strengthening the bridge with seismic retrofitting and structural rehabilitation of the bridge deck, repairs, and upgrades to barriers.
- Improving pedestrian access and safety by extending existing sidewalks and rehabilitating a pedestrian bridge.

**Proposed Schedule (Start-up, duration, and completion dates):**

The work is scheduled to begin Spring 2019 and end in 2021
