**Project Description:**

The proposed Project consists of:

- Replacing two segments of the bridge over Araz Wash to meet current flood and safety standards
- Segments A and B consisting of 6-span, 76-foot long RT/timber stringer trestle- ballast deck and 8-span, 98-foot long BM- ballast deck with a 16-span, 204-foot long pre-stressed concrete slab girder with timber ties
- The bridge will be constructed in two phases and use an off-track crane for construction
