- Placing 2 additional 36" Reinforced Concrete Pipe (RCP) Culverts on State Route (SR) 78 at Post Mile (PM) 75.17 and 1 additional 36" RCP culvert at PM 75.05
- Placing Rock Slope Protection (RSP) deceleration pads at each outlet
- Extending existing culverts at each location by 10 feet
- Repairing damaged slopes and placing RSP between PM 75.05 and 75.17 along the east slope of SR-78
