NOTICE OF INTENT
TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR PROPOSED REGULATIONS
TO ESTABLISH A MAXIMUM CONTAMINANT
LEVEL (MCL) FOR 1,2,3TRICHLOROPROPANE

(1,2,3-TCP)
The State Water Resources Control Board will consider adopting a Mitigated Negative Declaration for proposed regulations to establish an MCL for 1,2,3-TCP at 5 parts per trillion. The proposed regulations will be applicable statewide. The State Water Board is lead agency under the California Environmental Quality Act. Comments should be submitted as described in the notice available at: www.waterboards.ca.gov/drinking_water/123TCP.shtml

The Mitigated Negative Declaration is available at the CalEPA Building, 1001 i Street, Sacramento, CA 95814, at the above web address, or from DDW-RegUnit@waterboards. ca.gov. The review period begins March 4, 2017 and ends April 21, 2017. An Administrative Procedure Act public hearing will be held on April 19, 2017 during a Board Workshop to receive comments on the draft regulations. A public hearing for adoption of the regulations and the Mitigated Negative Declaration is planned for summer 2017.
