Fluoridation Non-Exemption List
January 1, 2003

Health and Safety Code Section 116415(a)(1)(A)(2) requires the Department of Health Services to prepare and distribute a list of public water systems that do not qualify for an exemption from the requirement to install and/or operate fluoridation treatment facilities effective January 1, 2003. This list applies to all public water systems in California that serve at least 10,000 service connections.

The following list identifies the public water systems in California that have received or anticipate receiving sufficient capital and associated costs for the installation of fluoridation treatment facilities from a funding source(s) that does not include the water system ratepayers, shareholders, local tax payers, bondholders, or any fees or charges levied by the water system.
