NOTICE OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION REVOCATION OF ACCREDITATION

Pursuant to Environmental Laboratory Accreditation Act (ELAA) Section 100915, Myro Enterprises Corporation dba Delta Environmental Laboratories (Delta) Environmental Laboratory Accreditation Program (ELAP) accreditation is IMMEDIATELY SUSPENDED. Delta shall discontinue the analysis of samples for all Fields of Accreditation. In addition, Delta is hereby noticed that its Certificate No. 1857 is REVOKED.

ELAP arrived for an on-site investigation and site assessment of Delta at 11:15 am on February 15, 2023. ELAP spoke with the laboratory director to request access to the laboratory. The laboratory director denied access to the laboratory during regular business hours. Pursuant to ELAA section 100865, ELAP may revoke the accreditation for a laboratory that does not allow an on-site assessment during regular business hours. Thus, ELAP is revoking the accreditation for Delta.

ELAP attempted the on-site assessment of Delta to ensure the competency of the laboratory to perform environmental analyses, particularly for drinking water Fields of Accreditation (FOA). Because Delta did not allow ELAP access to the laboratory, ELAP could not verify Delta's competency to perform drinking water sample analysis. In order to protect public health, ELAP is temporarily suspending all FOAs for Delta pursuant to ELAA section 100915.

If you disagree with the Temporary Suspension, you may request a hearing not later than 20 days from the date on which the notice is received.

If you disagree with the Revocation, you must submit a written request for a hearing within 20 days of receipt of this Notice. The hearing shall follow the timeline described in ELAA Section 100910 unless you request an extension. If you do not request a hearing within 20 days of receiving this Notice, the State Water Board may revoke the permit without a hearing.

Please note that the current accreditation for Delta expires on February 28, 2023, and there is no pending application for reaccreditation with ELAP. Delta's accreditation will expire by operation of law on February 28, 2023.
