### PROPOSITION 84, SECTION 75025 PREVENTION AND REDUCTION OF GROUNDWATER CONTAMINATION

#### FINAL SECOND ROUND PROJECT PRIORITY LIST

**ATTENTION:** The California Department of Public Health is pleased to announce the posting of the Proposition 84, Section 75025, Round 2 Project Priority List (PPL). This list is a compilation of eligible projects from the Round 2 application process.

In order to ensure consistency with our ranking process, the projects on the list have been assigned ranking points that are consistent with the procedures specified in the Proposition 84 Criteria, which was adopted on September 17, 2009, after extensive stakeholder reviews and public comment.

We would like to thank everyone who submitted comments during the Proposition 84 Draft Round 2 PPL 30-day public comment period that opened on January 27, 2012, and closed on February 26, 2012. The additional information provided during the public comment period was carefully reviewed and necessary changes were made to the final Round 2 PPL which may be viewed at the following website:

#### Fundable Projects for Proposition 84, Section 75025, Grant Funding

Projects on the PPL will be funded in the order they appear on the list from highest to lowest. Offer letters will be sent to the projects on the PPL based on their estimated grant amounts shown on the PPL and the availability of funds. As the project applications are evaluated to determine the eligibility of specific construction project components, funds may become available for additional projects on the PPL. As of April 20, 2012 there is approximately \$14.5 million available for Section 75025 projects.

If Proposition 84, Section 75025, grant funding is not available when the project is ready to enter into a funding agreement, CDPH will evaluate the project for possible funding under the Safe Drinking Water State Revolving Fund program.
