Project description: The North Marin Water District backflow meter and check valve installation project. This project will solve the category E ranked problem of lack of storage for times of drought and during emergency conditions. The current system draws from the Russian River, but the Sonoma County Water Agency (SCWA) issued an order to reduce the instream flow requirements for the Russian River which will deplete the water production of the off-river wells during the peak summer demand. To prevent cross-connection, check valves and flow meters will be installed on the existing distribution pipe that runs from the Russian River to the Stafford Lake which will allow for storage and supply during the summer months. A more thorough cost estimate was prepared and the total eligible cost increased from \$75,000 to \$86,286 due to increased cost of materials and construction.
