on the Matter of a Proposed Amendment to
the Water Quality Control Plan for the Lahontan Region
to remove a prohibition on constructing new piers in fish spawning habitat
at Lake Tahoe

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Lahontan Region (Water Board) staff will hold a California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) scoping meeting pursuant to the California Public Resources Code section 21083.9, as amended by AB 1532 to receive comments on the appropriate scope and content of the substitute environmental document to be prepared pursuant to Public Resources Code section 21080.5 of CEQA.

The proposed amendment would remove a Basin Plan Prohibition that prevents new pier construction in areas mapped as significant fish spawning habitat or in areas immediately offshore of important stream inlets in Lake Tahoe.

The prohibition on shoreline development in fish spawning habitat is a remnant of previous land use restrictions. Existing Tahoe Regional Planning Agency and Lahontan Regional Water Board regulatory oversight for new pier construction will provide each agency sufficient opportunity to review design considerations, assess construction methods, and require mitigation of any potential impact(s).
