

## NOTICE OF APPLICABILITY OF MUNICIPAL SEPARATE STORM SEWER SYSTEM PHASE II PERMIT, TOWN OF TRUCKEE

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Lahontan Region designated the Town of Truckee as a Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) under Phase II of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's Stormwater Phase II program on December 27, 2006.

A requirement of the designation included the submittal of a Stormwater Management Plan (SWMP). On December 7, 2007, The Town of Truckee provided a SWMP, applicable permit fees, and an application for coverage under Board Order Number 2003-0005-DWQ (MS4 Phase II Permit). The SWMP was subsequently posted on the State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) website and was subject to public review through March 25, 2008. No comments were received on the SWMP during this comment period; therefore, no public hearing is needed prior to issuing coverage under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit for Phase II MS4s. The MS4 Phase II Permit can be located on the State Water Quality Control Board website: <u>http://www.waterboards.ca.gov/stormwtr/docs/final\_sm\_ms4\_fact\_order.pdf</u>. A copy of the permit and attachments has been included with this correspondence.

I am hereby notifying the Town of Truckee that coverage under the MS4 Phase II Permit became effective on March 26, 2008. The Town of Truckee is subject to all of the requirements of the MS4 Phase II Permit in the areas within the Lahontan Region, outside of the Lake Tahoe Hydrologic Unit.
