As a member of the CAC and on behalf of the CAC, we are responding to the Proposed Cleanup and Abatement Order (CAO) No. R6V-2015-Prop Issued on January 21, 2015 by the Water Board. The CAC would like to have clarification on the rationale as to why the CAC is not mentioned in CAO No. R6V-2015-Prop.

The CAC would like the language from the original order CAO No. R6V-2011-0005A1 section 4b to be included into the current CAO No. R6V-2015-Prop. The language we suggest to be included into the current CAO is the following:

*“The Community Advisory Committee is the only existing group that may currently be viewed as representing the community.”*

If the Water Board does not find it relevant for the CAC to be mentioned in CAO No. R6V-2015-Prop, then the CAC would like the Water Board to formally acknowledge that the CAC is the voice for the community.

We look forward to continuing to work with the Water Board and other stakeholders to ensure that the plume is properly defined and that the correct remedy is implemented in Hinkley.
