Cluster 5 Returns Home, Clusters 6 & 7 Remediation Underway

The Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) is pleased to provide you with the latest update on the progress of the Carousel Community Cleanup:

- Cluster 5 cleanup and restoration are complete and residents moved back home during the first week of January.
- Cluster 6 excavation is complete, and restoration is underway.
- Cluster 7 residents moved to temporary housing the week of January 22nd.
- Cluster 8 residents are preparing to move out in April.
- Sound walls for the two concurrent cleanup clusters (Clusters 6 and 7) are up.
- The traffic pattern remains the same as for the previous cluster.

Come visit with the Regional Board Team at our information table in front of 24628 Marbella Avenue on Saturday, April 14, 2018 from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. It's an informal setting for you to drop by to ask questions, raise concerns, or share experiences about the cleanup activity, one-on-one with the Regional Board Team. No appointment is necessary. This event coincides with Shell's Open House.

Volunteer for the Outreach Committee

The Regional Board invites Carousel residents to participate in a one-year term on the Carousel Tract Cleanup Outreach Committee. The Committee meets monthly to discuss issues related to the cleanup process. Resident members have the opportunity to share community concerns with representatives from Shell, the City of Carson, and the Regional Board, and then report back to their neighbors on updates from the group. 
