ADOPTED WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT – JOINT OUTFALL SYSTEM, POMONA WATER RECLAMATION PLANT (NPDES NO. CA0053619, CI NO. 0755)

Our letter dated May 19, 2009, transmitted revised tentative Waste Discharge Requirements for your discharge of treated municipal and industrial wastewater from the Pomona Water Reclamation Plant (WRP) into the South Fork San Jose Creek.

Pursuant to Division 7 of the California Water Code, this Regional Board at a public hearing held on June 4, 2009, reviewed the revised tentative requirements, considered all factors in the case, and adopted Order No. <u>R4-2009-0076</u> (copies attached) with one change to a re-opener, relative to the Pomona WRP's waste discharge. Order No. <u>R4-2009-0076</u> serves as your NPDES permit, for the Pomona WRP and expires on May 10, 2014. Section 13376 of the California Water Code requires that a complete application for a new permit must be filed at least 180 days before the expiration date.

Table E-8 of the Monitoring and Reporting Program requires you to begin implementing the Continuous, Daily, and Weekly sampling during July, following the July 24, 2009 effective date. Monthly sampling shall begin on August 1, 2009 (on the first day of the calendar month following permit effective date or on permit effective date if that date is first day of the month). Your first monitoring report must be received in the Regional Board office by October 15, 2009, and will cover the Continuous, Daily, and Weekly sampling during the July 2009 period. Bioassessment annual monitoring is required to continue as was previously scheduled, during the 2009 spring/summer period.

When submitting monitoring or technical reports to the Regional Board, as required by your "Monitoring and Reporting Program", please send them <u>ATTN: Information Technology Unit</u> and include a reference to "Compliance File No. 0755" for the Pomona WRP. This will assure that the reports are directed to the appropriate file and staff. Also, please do not combine other reports with your monitoring reports. Submit each type of report as a separate document.
