**TERMINATION OF STATEWIDE GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AND REVISED MONITORING AND REPORTING PROGRAM CI NO. 10077 – HOWLAND'S POTABLE WATER WELL #3 LOCATED AT 100 HOWLAND LANDING, TWO HARBORS, LOS ANGELES COUNTY, CA 90704 (FILE NO. 14-082, STATE BOARD ORDER NO. 2003-0003-DWQ, SERIES NO. 017, CI NO. 10077, GLOBAL ID WDR100018638)**

Dear Mr. Gabr:


In our letter dated August 21, 2014, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under State Water Resources Control Board Water (State Water Board) Quality Order No. 2003-0003-DWQ, which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In the letter dated April 21, 2016, you notified the Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) that the pumping test was completed at the project site for which the permit was issued. And there is no other discharge anticipated at the project site; and that you request termination of the WDR.

Since the project for pumping test of the Howland's Well #3 has been completed and no further discharge of groundwater is planned, therefore, the WDR is no longer needed. The coverage under State Board Order No. 2003-0003-DWQ, Series No. 017, for the subject facility is hereby terminated, except for enforcement purposes under the term of the permit.
