TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMIT AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS—CHEVRON PIPELINE COMPANY, CHEVRON CULVER CITY PIPELINE, 6000 JEFFERSON BOULEVARD, CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG674001, CI-10091)

Dear Ms. Shreder:

In our letter dated October 1, 2014 we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2009-0068, Waste Discharge Requirements and General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit for Discharges of Low Threat Hydrostatic Test Water to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties, adopted on June 4, 2009.

On March 16, 2015, Envent Corporation (consultant) informed the Regional Board that Chevron Pipeline Company completed the above-referenced project and the subject NPDES permit is no longer needed. Since the NPDES permit is no longer necessary, Envent requested termination of coverage under the above-referenced General NPDES permit.

On April 27, 2015, Regional Board staff inspected the facility and verified that there is no discharge of hydrostatic water to the storm drain. Therefore, coverage under Board Order R4-2009-0068 for the subject site is hereby terminated, except for enforcement purposes

Please note that if future discharges of hydrostatic test water to surface water or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain appropriate Waste Discharge Requirements.
