Dear Mr. Galindo:

In our letter dated October 30, 2014, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2014-0141, Waste Discharge Requirements and General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit for Discharges of Groundwater from San Gabriel Valley Groundwater Basin to Surface Waters in Upper San Gabriel River and Rio Hondo Watersheds Los Angeles County, adopted by this Board on July 10, 2014

On January 19, 2016, you informed the Regional Board that the NPDES permit is no longer necessary and you requested termination of coverage under the above-referenced General NPDES permit.

Since the NPDES permit is no longer needed, coverage under Board Order R4-2014-0141 for the subject site is hereby terminated, except for enforcement purposes. Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface water or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain appropriate Waste Discharge Requirements.
