TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR IN-SITU GROUNDWATER REMEDIATION AND GROUNDWATER RE-INJECTION — FORMER ROEHL DISPOSAL CORPORATION SITE, 131 NORTH MARINE AVENUE, WILMINGTON, CALIFORNIA 90744 (FILE NO. 14-133, ORDER NO. R4-2014-0187, SERIES NO. 015, MONITORING AND REPORTING PROGRAM NO. CI-10113, GLOBAL ID WDR100020260)

Dear Mr. Cannon:

On May 18, 2015, the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) authorized the injection of materials under General Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R4-2014-0187, General Waste Discharge Requirements for In-Situ Groundwater Remediation and Groundwater Re-Injection (General WDRs), at the site referenced above. The authorized discharge was implemented under a June 2010, Corrective Measures Study Workplan approved by the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) in 2011.

On February 28, 2019, you requested termination of coverage under the General WDR because the reductive dechlorination pilot test using emulsified vegetable oil (EVO) was completed in October 2015, and quarterly monitoring has continued since then. Additional EVO injection is not planned. Therefore, the General WDR is no longer needed. Coverage under General WDR Order No. R4-2014-0187 is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.
