On March 20, 2015, the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board authorized the proposed subsurface injection of materials under the General Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR) Order No. R4-2014-0187. The authorized discharge was part of an approved *Remedial Action Plan Addendum* for groundwater remediation of petroleum hydrocarbon at the Pizza Hut Restaurant located at 1851 West Slauson Avenue, Los Angeles, California.

On June 5, 2019, you requested termination of coverage under the General WDR because injection of sodium persulfate was never implemented and is not planned in the future. Therefore, the WDR is no longer needed. Coverage under General WDR Order No. R4-2014-0187 for the subject site is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.
