TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS ORDER NO. R4-2014-0187, SERIES NO. 028 – FORMER UNIVAR USA, INC. FACILITY, 5353 JILLSON STREET, COMMERCE, CALIFORNIA 90400 (FILE NO. 15-146, WDR ORDER NO. R4-2014-0187, SERIES NO. 028, CL-10154, GLOBAL ID WDR100023421)

Dear Mr. Kleiman:

On April 23, 2015, Univar USA, Inc. (Univar) submitted a Report of Waste Discharge to inject potassium permanganate solution into groundwater as part of an in-situ chemical oxidation pilot test for the remediation of chlorinated volatile organic compounds, at the site referenced above.

On July 13, 2015, the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) authorized the injection under General Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R4-2014-0187, *General Waste Discharge Requirements for In-Situ Groundwater Remediation and Groundwater ReInjection* (General WDR). The authorized discharge was implemented under the February 20, 2015, *Draft Final In-Situ Chemical Oxidation Pilot Study Work Plan* (Work Plan). The Work Plan was approved by the Department of Toxic Substances Control on March 9, 2015.

On May 10, 2017, Univar requested termination of coverage under the General WDR because the permanganate injection and pilot test were completed. Additional injection is not planned at this time. Therefore, the General WDR is no longer needed. Coverage under General WDR Order No. R4-2014-0187 is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.


