TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMIT AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS— KIEWIT BUILDING GROUP, INC. — EXPO RAIL MAINTENANCE FACILITY, 1955 CENTINELA AVENUE, LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG674001, CI-10198)

Dear Mr. Welker:

In our letter dated November 23, 2015 we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2009-0068, Waste Discharge Requirements and General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit for Discharges of Low Threat Hydrostatic Test Water to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties, adopted on June 4, 2009.

On December 17, 2015, you informed the Regional Board that Kiewit Building Group, Inc. (Kiewit) found an alternative to discharging the hydrostatic test water to surface waters. The water was pumped to the City of Santa Monica Urban Runoff Recycling Facility and reused for irrigation and other non-potable uses. No hydrostatic test water was discharged to surface waters. Since the NPDES permit is no longer necessary, you requested termination of coverage under the above-referenced General NPDES permit.

Since the NPDES permit is no longer needed, coverage under Board Order R4-2009-0068 for the subject site is hereby terminated, except for enforcement purposes. Please note that if future discharges of hydrostatic water to surface water or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain appropriate Waste Discharge Requirements
