TERMINATION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS – EL RODEO SCHOOL, 605 NORTH WHITTIER DRIVE, BEVERLY HILLS, CALIFORNIA (FILE NO. 16-036, CI-10230, ORDER NO. R4-2014-0187, SERIES NO. 069, GLOBAL ID WDR1000039424)

Dear Ms. Johnson:

On July 11, 2016, the Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Regional Board Order No. R4-2014-0187, which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs).

In a letter dated June 6, 2018, Mr. Maulik J. Bavishi of RPS (formerly Iris Environmental), on behalf of Beverly Hills Unified School District, notified the Regional Board that the injection of chemicals at the site was completed in July 2016. Since you have no plan to inject chemicals in the future, the coverage under Regional Board Order No. R4-2014-0187 for the subject site is hereby terminated, with the exception of enforcement under the terms of the permit.
