TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR IN-SITU GROUNDWATER REMEDIATION AND GROUNDWATER RE-INJECTION – ALL-TEX INKS CORPORATION, 14650 EAST FIRESTONE BOULEVARD, LA MIRADA, CALIFORNIA (FILE NO. 16-061, ORDER NO. R4-2014-0187, SERIES NO. 070, CI-10231, GLOBAL ID. WDR 100039446)

Dear Mr. Mehta:

On July 7, 2017, the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board authorized the proposed subsurface injection of materials under the General Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR) Order No. R4-2014-0187. The authorized discharge was part of an approved *Pre-Design Investigation and Pilot Test Work Plan* for groundwater remediation of volatile organic compounds at the All-Tex Inks facility.

On December 31, 2019, you requested termination of coverage under the General WDR because injection of EHC amendment and bioaugmentation culture was never implemented and is not planned in the future. Therefore, the WDR is no longer needed. Coverage under General WDR Order No. R4-2014-0187 for the subject site is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.
