TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR IN-SITU GROUNDWATER REMEDIATION AND GROUNDWATER RE-INJECTION – HONEYWELL TORRANCE FACILITY, 2525 WEST 190TH STREET, TORRANCE, CALIFORNIA (FILE NO. 16-120, ORDER NO. R4-2014-0187, SERIES NO. 082, CI-10268, GLOBAL ID. WDR100039534)

Dear Mr. Wu:

On June 16, 2017, the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board authorized the proposed injection of treated groundwater under the General Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR) Order No. R4-2014-0187. The authorized discharge was for pilot test activities as part of an approved *Groundwater Interim Remedial Measure Work Plan* for groundwater remediation of volatile organic compounds at the Honeywell Torrance facility.

On June 3, 2019, you requested termination of coverage under the General WDR because injection of treated groundwater associated with pilot test activities was completed in July 2018. Therefore, the WDR is no longer needed for these activities. Coverage under General WDR Order No. R4-2014-0187 for the subject site is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes. However, Honeywell International, Inc. is required to submit a Report of Waste Discharge for discharges associated with a full-scale groundwater remediation system.
