## TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS—CALIFORNIA AMERICAN WATER, ARLINGTON WELL, 5109 ARLINGTON AVENUE, LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG914001, CI– 10326)

Dear Mr. Lasecki:

The subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2013-0043, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges Treated Groundwater From Investigation and/or Cleanup of Volatile Organic Compounds Contaminated-Sites to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Regional Water Board on April 7, 2013.

We have received your email of October 31, 2019, requesting termination of your coverage CI-10326 under the Board Order R4-2013-0043. The email indicated that the treated wastewater discharge from Arlington Well at the subject facility is now regulated under Order R4-2018-0087, CI-10445 issued on December 19, 2018, and that the subject NPDES permit enrollment under CI-10326 is no longer needed.

We have reviewed and concur with your request. Therefore, coverage under Board Order R4-2013-0043, General NPDES permit enrollment CI-10326 for the facility is hereby terminated, except for enforcement purposes.
