WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AND TIME SCHEDULE ORDER FOR CITY OF FILLMORE (FILLMORE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT), C STREET, FILLMORE, CALIFORNIA (FILE NO. 54-105, CI-1076)

Our letter of March 27, 2006, transmitted revised tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) including Monitoring and Reporting Program, and an accompanying tentative Time Schedule Order (TSO) for the Fillmore Wastewater Treatment Plant and new Fillmore Wastewater Recycling Plant.

Pursuant to Division 7 of the California Water Code, this Regional Board at a public meeting held on May 11, 2006, reviewed the revised tentative WDRs and the tentative TSO, considered all factors in the case, and adopted WDRs Order No. R4-2006-0049 and TSO Order No. R4-2006-00050 (copies enclosed) relative to this discharge. Standard Provisions, which are a part of the WDRs, are also enclosed.

You are required to implement the Monitoring and Reporting Program No. CI-1076 on the effective date of Order No. R4-2006-0049. Your first monitoring report under these Requirements is due to this Regional Board by July 15, 2006. All monitoring reports should be sent to the Regional Board, Attn: Information Technology Unit, and please reference all monitoring reports to our Compliance File No. CI-1076.

We are sending the WDRs, MRP, and TSO to the Discharger (City of Fillmore) only. For recipients on the mailing list, an electronic or hard copy of these enclosures will be furnished upon request.
