WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AND TIME SCHEDULE ORDER FOR CITY OF FILLMORE (FILLMORE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT), C STREET, FILLMORE, CALIFORNIA (FILE NO. 54-105, CI-1076)

Our letter of March 27, 2006, transmitted revised tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) including Monitoring and Reporting Program, and an accompanying tentative Time Schedule Order (TSO) for the Fillmore Wastewater Treatment Plant and new Fillmore Wastewater Recycling Plant.

Pursuant to Division 7 of the California Water Code, this Regional Board at a public meeting held on May 11, 2006, reviewed the revised tentative WDRs and the tentative TSO, considered all factors in the case, and adopted WDRs Order No. R4-2006-0049 and TSO Order No. R4-2006-00050 (copies enclosed) relative to this discharge.
