ADOPTED RESOLUTION NO. R26-002 APPROVING 2026-2028 SPECIAL STUDY – HYPERION WATER RECLAMATION PLANT (NPDES PERMIT NO. CA0109991, CI-1492) AND TERMINAL ISLAND WATER RECLAMATION PLANT (NPDES PERMIT NO. CA0053856, CI-2171)

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Los Angeles Water Board) transmitted a letter containing the Tentative Resolution Approving a 2026-2028 Special Study for the Hyperion Water Reclamation Plant (HWRP) and the Terminal Island Water Reclamation Plant (TIWRP) on May 14, 2026.

In accordance with administrative procedures, the Los Angeles Water Board at a public hearing held on June 25, 2026, reviewed the tentative Resolution, considered all the factors in the case, and adopted Resolution No. R26-002.
