ADOPTED TERMINATION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs) AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT FOR THE CITY OF SANTA PAULA – SANTA PAULA WASTEWATER RECLAMATION FACILITY (SANTA PAULA WRF), SANTA PAULA, CA (NPDES NO. CA0054224, CI NO. 1759)

Our letter dated March 15, 2012, transmitted a copy of the tentative Order which would terminate the WDRs and NPDES permit for the Santa Paula WRF, located at 905 Corporation Street, Santa Paula, California.

TERMINATING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS
AND
NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMIT
FOR DISCHARGES IN THE LOS ANGELES REGION

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Regional Water Board), finds:

1. This Regional Water Board adopted waste discharge requirements (WDRs) for discharge to surface waters, which also served as the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit for the Discharger listed below.
2. The discharge to surface waters from this facility has been eliminated and/or is covered under a separate Non-NPDES WDRs Order.
3. Therefore, the following WDRs and NPDES permit is no longer necessary and should be terminated.
4. The following Order is hereby terminated, except for enforcement purposes.
5. The termination of WDRs is exempt from the provisions of Chapter 3 (commencing with Section 21100), Division 13, Public Resources Code, in accordance with Water Code Section 13389.

The Regional Water Board has notified the Discharger, interested agencies, and persons of its intent to consider termination of the following waste discharge requirements and has provided them with an opportunity to submit their written views and recommendations.

The Regional Water Board, in a public hearing, heard and considered all comments and testimony pertinent to this matter.



Terminating Waste Discharge Requirements
and NPDES Permit

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following waste discharge requirements and NPDES permit be terminated:

City of Santa Paula (Santa Paula Wastewater Reclamation Facility), 905 Corporation Street, Santa Paula (CA0054224)	97-041 (April 7, 1997)	The City of Santa Paula abandoned the facility and redirected influent to a newly constructed wastewater facility, which discharges under a separate Order.

The Executive Officer of the Regional Water Board is authorized and directed to certify and submit copies of this Order to the Discharger and to such individuals and governmental agencies as may have need therefore or may request the same.
